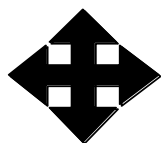

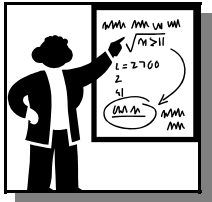

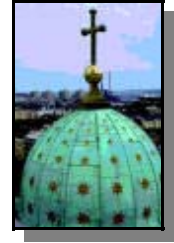

Multimedia Technician
