Counseling Center

The Counseling Center has extended an invitation to the principals and guidance directors in the nearby boys' archdiocesan high schools to participate in a conference on problems involved in counseling students. The Director of the Center will present ideas on the ways a college counseling center can serve high school students who are considering college and also serve the high school faculty. The Assistant Director of the Center will present ideas regarding group procedures as these are adapted to counseling and guidance on the high school level. Representatives of approximately twenty-five schools have been invited to participate.

Careers and Courses is presently being distributed to all of the high schools in this area. Each boys' archdiocesan high school has been offered up to fifty copies of Careers and Courses free of charge for use in home room guidance. Several schools already have requested this number.
