**RE: Important News About Credit Card Payments**

La Salle University is devoted to providing the best possible education to our students. At the same time, we are deeply aware of the financial sacrifices our students and their families must make in order to afford a college education. Because of this, we are constantly seeking ways, both large and small, to reduce our expenses and become more efficient.

All colleges and universities are facing this dilemma: to provide students with a range of payment options but at the same time trying to reduce costs. Many no longer accept credit cards for payments because costs are so high, and we too have considered this option. However, we realize that many of our students and their families need the convenience of paying by credit card. Accordingly, we have partnered with Sallie Mae Solutions to enable you to use a credit or debit card for your La Salle charges. **Sallie Mae will charge a fee for this service. That fee will vary according to the type of credit or debit card that you use.**

Beginning **June 1, 2005**, The Bursar's Office will no longer accept credit or debit card payments through the mail, in person, or over the phone. The Sallie Mae/La Salle Payment Gateway will be available to accept credit and debit card payments for University-related expenses. All La Salle invoices will provide detailed instructions that will direct you to this secure Gateway where you will be able to make a full or partial payment. Detailed instructions will also be provided in the Bursar's section of the La Salle website at [www.lasalle.edu](http://www.lasalle.edu).

As we make this change, we want to reassure our students and their families that we will continue to provide a number of flexible payment options:

- La Salle University Deferred Payment Plan

Thank you for your understanding. This was a difficult decision. However, we feel it is in the best interest of all of our students to try to reduce expenses as much as possible so that we can offer the highest quality education.
