All residential facilities will officially close for the year on Friday, May 5, 2006, at 6:00 p.m.

For students to be considered for a housing extension for the end of the year, requests must be submitted to Administrative Services prior to April 21, 2006. Request forms are available on mylasalle under the Administrative Services tab on the Student Affairs channel. *Please be sure to review the Procedures for Requesting a Housing Extension prior to submitting the request.*

A list of approved extensions will be sent to the appropriate departments and administrators on Wednesday, April 26, 2006. Please note that a majority of these students will need to move into Extended Housing in North Halls.

No guests are permitted in any residential facility during this period. Summer Housing residents will be permitted to sign-in guests after May 13, 2006.

Re: **Procedures for Early Arrival Requests for Fall 2006**

In an effort to organize requests submitted by students, faculty, and staff, the *Procedures for Early Arrival Requests* have been developed to ensure the University Community is aware of what students have a need to be on campus prior to Opening Day scheduled for August 24, 2006. *Permission for early arrival will be at the discretion of the Division of Student Affairs.*

WHO

Students who have a need to be on campus prior to Opening Day may include those 1) participating in athletic training, 2) arriving early due to international flights, 3) involved in Day ONE, or 4) working for a University office.

Additional consideration may be permitted to specific student groups in order to focus on specific leadership development and Opening Weekend efforts. The list below outlines the groups who should work directly with Pete Lafferty, Community Coordinator for Leadership Development, to obtain approval to move back early. In addition, each group will have a separate move-in date and requirements for moving in early.

- Group 1** Groups with a defined role in Opening and Opening Weekend
8 POINT Organizations, RA/CA Staff, PEERS, Team Leaders, USA, HSA, Ambassadors
- Group 2** Groups without a defined role in Opening and Opening Weekend
For example: Collegian, Explorer, or the Masque
- Group 3** Supporting cast with more specific roles in Opening Weekend
For example: a Greek organization

WHERE

The *Early Arrival Request Form* may be found on the Student Affairs Channel in mylasalle.

WHEN

Early Arrival Request Forms are **due prior to July 14, 2006**. Requests received after this deadline will not be approved.

Early arrival dates for those with approved requests are as follows:

- Saturday, August 12, 2006 (Student athletes)
- Saturday, August 19, 2006 (AEP students, Group 1, Group 2, or student athletes)
- Tuesday, August 22, 2006 (Final Day One participants, Group 3, or international students)

HOW

Students as individuals may submit an Early Arrival Request Form, **OR** faculty and/or staff may submit the form on their students' behalf.

Individual Submission

Any resident student with a reason to arrive early, including those involved in campus organizations, will be required to complete the *Early Arrival Request Form*. This form may be found on the Student Affairs channel through mylasalle and must be submitted no later than July 14, 2006. Requests received after this deadline will not be approved.

Faculty/Staff Submission

Complete the *Early Arrival Request Form* on behalf of your student(s) or student group(s). This form may be used to submit one name or multiple names comprising a group, **OR** Submit a list prepared in Microsoft Excel with 1) the name(s) and I.D. number(s) of the student(s) and 2) the early arrival date being requested. Email this list to Karen Kostelny, the Housing Services Associate, at kostelny@lasalle.edu prior to the deadline date of July 14, 2006.

The Unit staff member within Student Affairs who normally works with International and the final, by-invitation Day One students should submit their Early Arrival Requests by the deadline date of July 14, 2006. Use the Student Organizations classification for these groups.

For room reservations and audio/visual needs please submit requests through the Union Services Director, Kyra Braun, at (215) 951-1370.

All requests for Early Arrivals for fall 2006 will be due no later than July 14, 2006. Students who wish to be considered for early arrivals after the deadline date will be subject to a late fee of \$50.00 that will be assessed to the student account or department account.

All groups must provide the details requested in order to be approved for staying on campus.

- PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING: Graphics submitted may be resized to fit the document layout. Logos, signatures, and other graphics that are likely to be used frequently can be kept on file for future use. Please add a comment to this effect when you submit your graphic.
