

Concerns regarding the operation of the Faculty Dining Room (FDR) have recently been brought to the attention of the Vice President of Business Affairs by the Faculty Senate.

In responding to the issues raised, the Vice President has met with the Food Service staff to review the Senate's observations. The department recognizes that service demands in FDR have increased significantly (over 19%) as compared to last years' guest counts. We believe this increase is due in part to the displacement of some staff members that depended upon the Union cafeteria for lunch and now find the Food Court lines undesirable.

While the provision of quality service has always been a priority of the FDR staff; over the years certain accommodations have been made to respond to specific customer requests. In assessing operational procedures which would enhance the level of service in the FDR, the department has recommended that the following be implemented:

1. **END RESERVATIONS** The practice of accepting reservations for small groups will be discontinued. Hopefully this will facilitate the turnover of tables and enable the staff to serve additional guests. All FDR customers will be seated on a **first come first serve** basis.
2. **MAXIMUM SEATING** In order to efficiently utilize the resources (tables & chairs) available in the FDR, the maximum seating at any given table will be **limited to 6 guests**.
3. **PREFERENTIAL TREATMENT** In order for the wait staff to expedite service in the FDR, customers will be seated at the first table available within the rotational assignment. The practice of seating a customer at their "favorite table" or with their "favorite waitress" will be discontinued.
4. **DELAY IN PAYING BILL** Supervisory personnel will be available during peak operational hours in order to assist the hostess with expediting the check out line.

In addition to the above recommendations, the department will also be opening a new facility available only to the Faculty & Staff. The concept is a "quick lunch" alternative comprised of a limited "Soup, Salad & Sandwich" menu which will be offered on a cash only basis. This new venture will begin:

Hopefully, the recommendations proposed by Food Services and approved by the Vice President of Business Affairs will provide for a noticeable improvement in the level of service in the FDR.

We further realize that it will be the cooperative effort of the faculty and staff in determining the success of these recommendations and therefore acknowledge your understanding and cooperation in this regard.
