## Drug and Alcohol Program

### ALCOHOL ON THE BRAIN

■ Thinking that you're drinking can make you tipsy. In a University of Washington course, students are given alcohol-free malt drinks, and vodka and tonics without the vodka. "After they think they have been drinking alcohol for 45 minutes, they get more relaxed and outgoing, and a party atmosphere develops," says a university researcher. "Then we tell them, 'Guess what? You haven't had any alcohol.' The 'placebo effect' teaches them how much of their behavioral change was due to expectancy and nothing else."

### ALCOHOL ON THE BREATH

■ You may or may not know that mouthwash can contain up to 26.9 percent alcohol. Targeting parents upset by the 3,916 cases of mouthwash poisoning reported to the American Association of Poison Centers in 1989, and diabetics monitoring calories and insulin levels, Spectrum Consumer Products Co. has introduced Spritz, an alcohol-free mouthwash, says U.S. News & World Report.
