Dr. Joseph Turow's postponed program in the Series has been rescheduled for Thursday, March 21, at 12:30 p.m. in Olney 100. Dr. Turow's topic will be "Advertising and the Commercialization of Childhood," and the program will be illustrated with examples of television commercials.

Dr. Turow is a Professor in the Annenberg School of Communication at the University of Pennsylvania. He has published numerous studies of the mass media in professional journals and several books, including **Entertainment, Education, and the Hard Sell: Three Decades of Network Children's Television** and **Playing Doctor: Television, Storytelling, and Medical Power.**
