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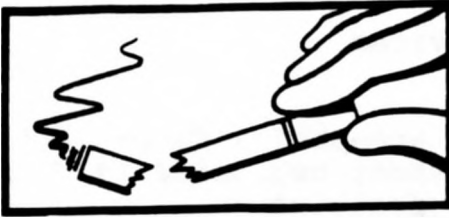

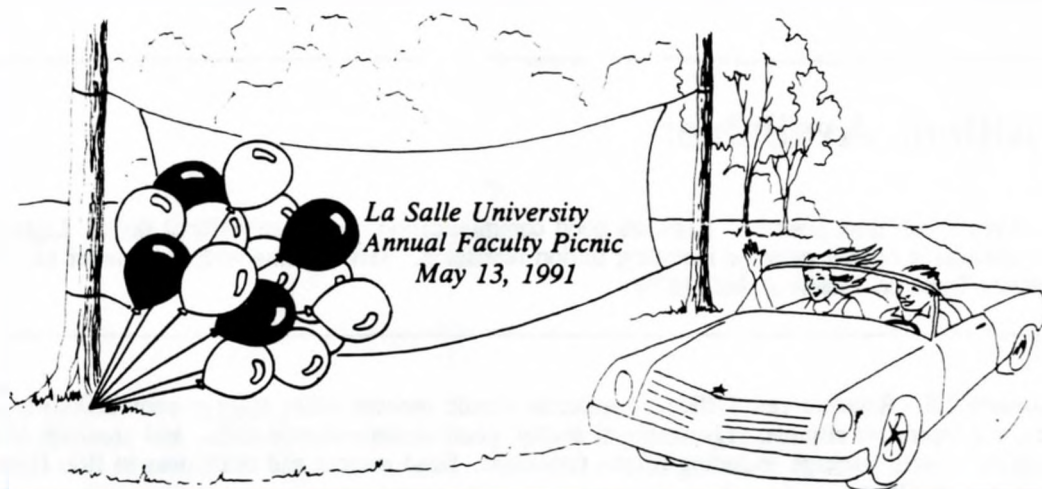

2. Donations of BOOKS, JOURNALS and TEACHING EQUIPMENT

TWINNING: As you probably know, the De La Salle Christian Brothers (FSC) conduct some 1200 schools in about 80 countries world-wide. Of the 14 higher education institutions, we are "twinned" with Univ. of St. La Salle, (USLS), for purposes of mutual support and co-operation. We are interested in developing the "twinning" further. Feel free to write (air mail takes about 14 days) to your corresponding department, office or activity at the above address. Exchange of reports, textbook lists, syllabi, newsletters, policies, handbooks, etc. may be mutually beneficial. Enclosed is a list of some of the USLS staff and faculty. Students may want to contact and write to "pen pals".

BOOKS, JOURNALS: As the semester ends, you may have some time to sort thru things you or your department no longer need. We expect 3 persons from the Philippine Library Materials Project (PLMP) to be here June 10-22 to re-pack the donations and take them to a North Jersey dock.

USLS Library is interested in books and journals published after 1983 and at the college or graduate level in any subject area. "Classics" in a subject area or journal collections that date before 1983 are also useful. Encyclopedias "one edition out" are desired.

TEACHING EQUIPMENT: USLS and PLMP are also interested in computers, teaching materials, typewriters, microfiche/film readers, microscopes, etc. that you no longer use but are still working and in good physical condition.

Please contact me at 951-1428 if you or your department have something to donate. If you wish to get US income tax credit, feel free to compose an appropriate letter with details of your donation and I'll be happy to have it re-typed and sign it.

Considering foreign exchange rates, transit costs, customs duties, etc., a \$20 US book costs about P500 (Pesoes) in the Philippines. That would be as valuable as \$500 to you and me in the US. Thus, your contributions are very helpful. The USLS Brothers and Library staff and the PLMP director sent their warm appreciation for last year's generous donations. Generally, we have averaged about 50 boxes of books per year.

In August, I will be going to USLS, Bacolod for 3 years. I would appreciate someone volunteering to take over this end of the process.
