We would like to extend a sincere thank you to all the departments who assisted us with the many details involved in conducting Continuing Professional Education's summer programs.

The grant funded children's **Why I Should Be Proud to Live in Philadelphia** completed its five week program on Friday, August 7 with a pizza party in Backstage. When the children were not on field trips around Philadelphia, they were receiving language instruction in their summer classroom in Williamson Lounge and enjoying the grounds on the Main Campus.

August 7 was also the culmination for the adult **English as a Second Language** program which brought students from six countries and Puerto Rico. This group spent five weeks studying the English language and cross-cultural strategies, and traveled from New York to Washington as part of their study program. The resident students were able to further enrich their cultural experience by spending a weekend with families of the La Salle community.
