Subject: 1992 Tax Changes  
Date: January 3, 1992

Social Security and Medicare Taxes: Both the employer and employee Social Security and Medicare tax rates will remain at 7.65% for the 1992 calendar year. The 7.65% rate will continue to be separated into two tax rates applied to different taxable wage bases as follows:

- 6.2% is considered the Social Security tax rate applied to a taxable wage base of \$55,500;
- 1.45% is considered the Medicare tax rate applied to a taxable wage base of \$130,200.

Federal Withholding Taxes: The Internal Revenue Service has issued new federal withholding tax tables and rates effective January 1, 1992. The tax rates will remain at 15%, 28%, and 31%. The value of a single withholding allowance has increased from \$2,150 to \$2,300 for the 1992 calendar year.

Pennsylvania Income Tax: The Pennsylvania income tax rate has decreased from 3.5% to 3.1% effective January 1, 1992 through June 30, 1992. As of July 1, 1992, the tax rate is scheduled to further decrease to 2.8% for the remainder of the calendar year.


