## COORDINATOR OF MULTICULTURAL RESEARCH AND OUTREACH

La Salle University invites applications for the nine month, full-time position of Coordinator of Multicultural Research and Outreach.

The Coordinator of Multicultural Research and Outreach is responsible for the development and management of a Center of Multicultural Research and Outreach. **Specific duties include:** developing viable and effective partnerships with the major civic, religious, business, and educational leaders of the various ethnic and minority communities within the Delaware Valley area; strengthening the University's outreach to the Hispanic communities in Philadelphia; serving as a resource to various University personnel on Hispanic issues; compiling data, including articles and studies, on ethnic and minority groups within the Philadelphia area; collaborating with the Director of the Urban Studies Center, the Coordinator of School Initiatives and other University leadership who work with minority groups both within the University and outside of it.

The Coordinator of Multicultural Research and Outreach reports to the Provost through the Assistant Provost for Multicultural and International Affairs.

**Requires:** Master's degree; at least five years administrative experience; extensive experience in the development of outreach programs for minority groups; background in working with Hispanic communities; fluency in Spanish; proven ability to work with civic, religious, business and educational leaders; demonstrated creative leadership ability; excellent managerial, communications and organizational skills; the ability to communicate and work within culturally diverse settings.
