Martin Luther King, Jr.
1929-1968

When he was only twenty-six years old, King told those gathered at the first meeting of the Montgomery bus boycott, "If you will protest courageously, and with dignity and Christian love, when the history books are written in future generations, the historians will have to pause and say, 'There lived a great people--a black people--who injected new meaning into the veins of civilization.' This is our challenge and our overwhelming responsibility."

King believed that an energized and spiritualized Black America in possession of its self-respect and committed to change could heal at the deepest ontological levels, as well as at the most practical and existential levels, the diseased psyche of racist America and by so doing rock an empire the same way the early Christians had once rocked Rome. To do so they would have to find the form, the language, and the will to mobilize their quest for justice even if the white majority of Americans simply refused to recognize the problem. He found the form in Gandhian nonviolence, the language in the Bible, and the will in the just indignation of Black Americans. But it was his particular gift to synthesize all three of these ingredients in his voice, a voice that shook the very foundations of the American conscience.

It will be on at 8:35 p.m. (Philadelphia time).

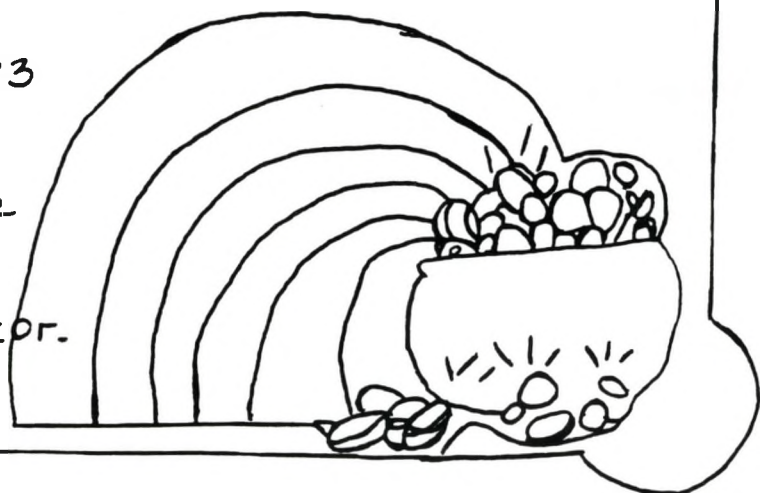
