
TO: Faculty, School of Arts & Sciences


If you have a suggestion for the next medalist, the committee would be grateful if you would share your idea with them. Please submit your recommendations to:

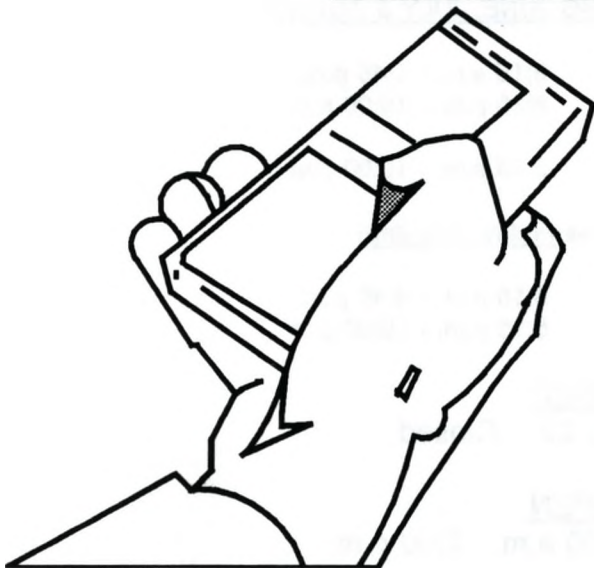

Gertrude Coogan was the mother of Brother Colman Coogan, Provincial and member of the Board of Trustees.

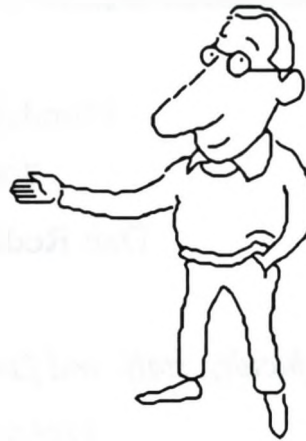
