Edward Nickerson will be joining the La Salle Community on September 5th in the newly established position of Director of Information Technology. Mr. Nickerson was strongly recommended by the Search Committee. He joins us after eighteen years of senior level service with the Federal Government.

The Director of Information Technology will be responsible for both administrative and academic computing. The two organizational units, Administrative Computing and Academic Computing, will be unified into a single center and staff over a period of time. As we enter this period of transition, I want to acknowledge, on behalf of the entire campus community, our deep appreciation to all those individuals who have supported campus computing in recent years.

The August 25, 1995 issue of Campus News highlights the many accomplishments of Jack Porcelli during the ten years he served as Director of Computer Resources.

I would also note here the major contributions to campus computing made by Steve Longo as Director of Academic Computing and Technology. His vision and his commitment to always being on the leading edge of technology has provided excellent support for faculty both in teaching and in research. Even in a resource constrained environment, Steve has had a major impact on campus technology. His leadership has been recognized locally by professional peer groups such as PACS and nationally by software producers such as Microsoft. He will be returning to faculty status during the 1995-96 academic year.

Both Jack and Steve have been supported by competent and committed professional staffs. These many individuals keep technology service levels high on a daily basis for the campus community. We will continue to rely on them for quality service as the University moves forward.

Finally, I would like to thank the Search Committee for a thorough and most conscientious job during the middle of the summer. Under the Chairmanship of Sam Wiley the Committee was staffed by: Jim Cooper, Peggy McManus, Susan Rohanna, Tom Straub, and Steve Thorpe.

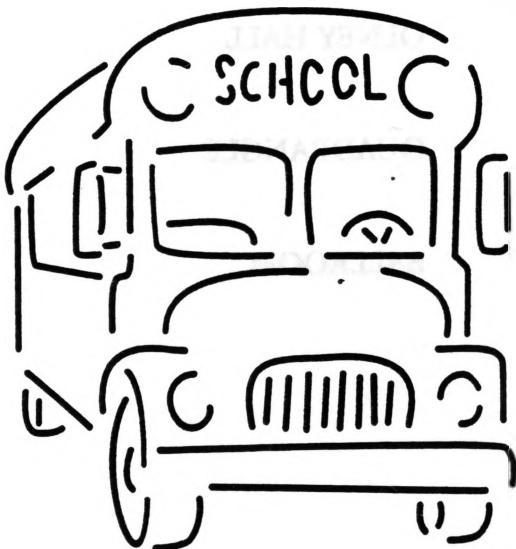
