RE: The Position of Provost

In March, following an open meeting with the Faculty Senate, I established a search committee to assist in the selection of the Provost. The search was internal, and two candidates were interviewed by the search committee, Faculty Senate, and groups of administrators. Consistent with the advice garnered from these groups, and after consultation with University Council, I have asked Dr. Joseph Kane to serve as Provost. Dr. Kane has graciously accepted the position.

As you know, Dr. Kane served as Dean of the School of Business Administration for 10 years, and has been at La Salle for 33 years. He founded our highly respected M.B.A. program, and for the past 8 years has successfully led us through the AACSB accreditation process. His 6 months as Interim Provost have been marked by collaborative leadership and the emergence of a new vision of how we can maintain, enrich, and integrate the educational and social experiences of our students.

I know that Dr. Kane can count on the support and encouragement of all of us as he fulfills the critical responsibilities of his position.
