Minutes of the May 2, 1996 Meeting

1. Minutes of the April 19, 1996 Meeting.

A motion was approved (7-0-1) to modify the wording of the motion concerning CHM 170, Forensic Science. The revised motion will be incorporated into the 4/19/96 minutes. With this change, minutes of 4/19/96 were approved.

2. Certification Programs in General Science and Environmental Education.

Br. Larry Colhocker, Chair of the Education Department, presented a proposal to offer teacher certification programs in general science and environmental education for secondary education majors. Neither would involve new courses. All courses necessary are already offered. The programs would be administered by the Education Department in consultation with the Science Department Chairs. If approved, these proposed certification programs would be forwarded to the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) for review and approval at that level.

The Programs have been reviewed and approved by the School of Arts and Sciences Curriculum Committee.

Multiple reasons for offering these certification programs were noted including:

- * PDE is likely to require environmental education in the near future
- * these will help La Salle to improve science education
- * only two other area colleges offer environmental education certifications
- * will expand IAMST outreach to areas high schools
- * in hiring new teachers, principals need generalists as well as those with more specialized training in science.

An extended discussion focused on specifics of the proposed curriculum.

A motion, **To approve the Certification Programs in General Science and Environmental Education as proposed**, was approved (8-0-0).
