Subject: Fire Hydrant Project

During a routine inspection by the Philadelphia Fire Department it was noted that the existing fire hydrant on main campus did not meet the current City of Philadelphia Fire Prevention Code and we were cited for the deficiency. In order to be compliant, the existing hydrant system must be expanded.

Construction will begin in early to mid June and begin in the area outside of Holroyd Science Center. Trenching will be approximately 18 inches wide and 4 feet deep and will be back-filled at the completion of each workday. The project is expected to be completed in approximately six weeks, weather permitting.
