We seek an advisor for La Salle University's student newspaper, *The Collegian*. This is a part-time, academic year position.

The advisor actively advises the editors and staff on all aspects of professional journalism; creates and maintains a professional environment within which the editors and staff can produce a newspaper that will most effectively serve the university community; establishes procedures for staff recruitment, training, and promotion; assists with business and managerial matters; and serves as liaison for the Student Press Committee (of which the advisor is a member *ex officio*) in its post-publication reviews of *The Collegian* or, when requested, pre-publication reviews.

The advisor may be a member of the faculty or administration of La Salle University. Consideration also will be given to full-time journalism professionals or advanced graduate students. The advisor should be able to work with students who have varying levels of ability and interest and should be (or become) knowledgeable about the university's people and programs.
