PARKING REQUEST DURING FRESHMAN "MOVE-IN"

"Opening Weekend" is scheduled to begin on Thursday August 22nd. On that day incoming freshman students and their families will arrive to move students into their residences.

As in past years, most of the activity will be concentrated at the North Halls Complex, 20th & Olney Avenue, making for traffic congestion and challenging parking for unloading along Olney Avenue.

Recently, there have been several phone calls to La Salle Departments by unauthorized suppliers selling Copier, Printer and/or Fax Toner at inflated prices.

Should you receive a sales call, the best response is to state you are not interested. The University's authorized suppliers will not call to sell toner.

Copier Supplies

The University's authorized copier maintenance contract includes the cost for copier toner supplies at a discounted rate. Check the ID label on your copier for the phone number of your Service Maintenance Company, and call only that number when toner is needed. If you are not sure of your copier maintenance company, please feel free to call Purchasing at 1863.

Printer and Fax Toner

Printer and fax toner prices are included in the Office Basics office supplies contract. Original equipment manufacturer brands, and remanufactured toner by Data Products (as approved by IT) are available. For Okidata fax toner call Purchasing for vendor pricing.

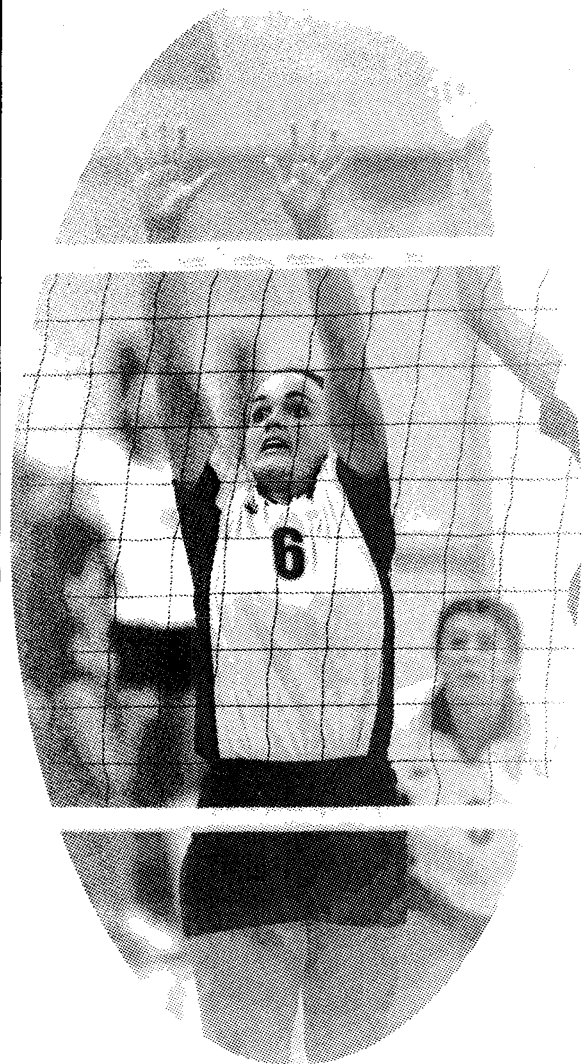

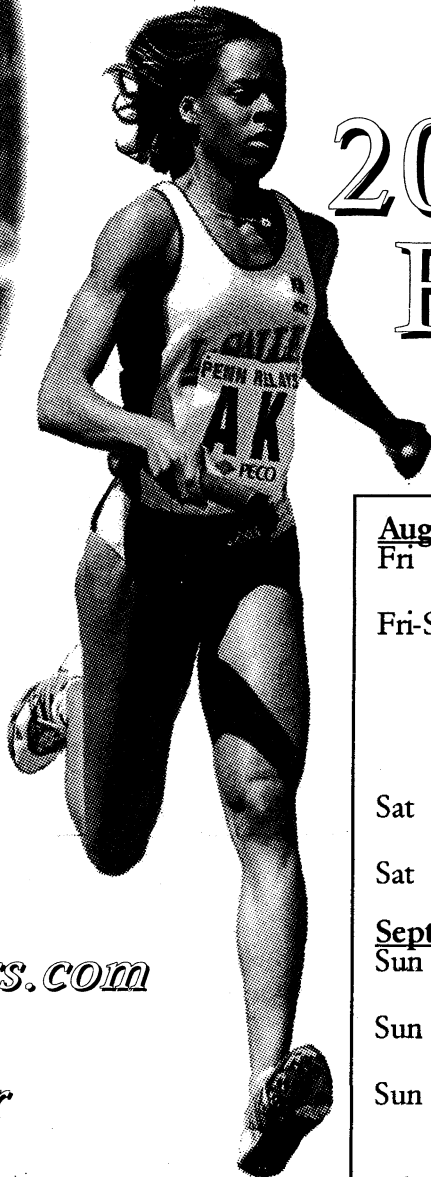
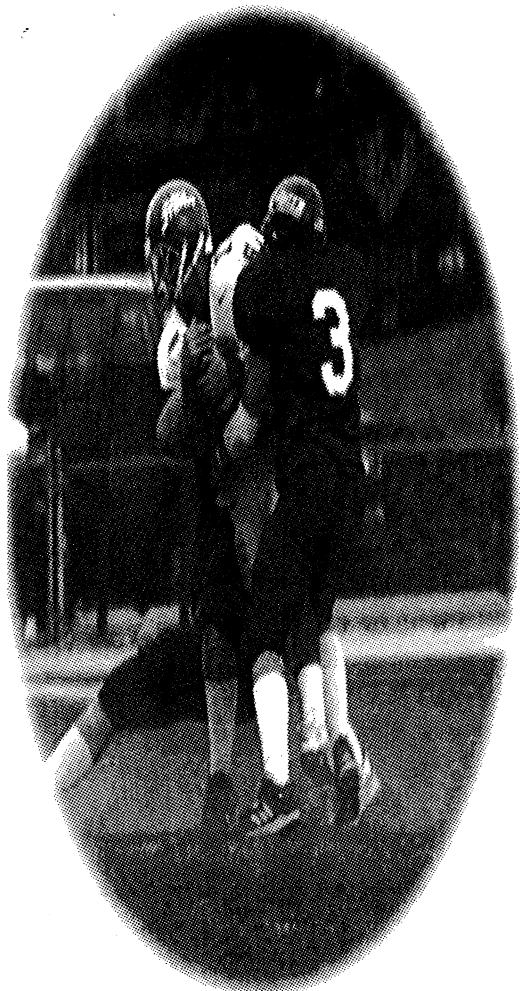
